



Kiddy Up Ranch Safe Return Plan

The Kiddy Up Safe Return will be done in 3 phases.

Phase 1: Completely Independent Riders.

Phase 2: Riders requiring horse leaders.

Phase 3: Riders requiring leaders and side walkers.

Each Student will be contacted individually to return to lessons based on the above guidelines.

No Lessons requiring Back Riding will be offered at this time.

The Petting Zoo and Playground will remain closed at this time.

Progression through the phases will be based on the continued downward trending of state Covid-19 cases.

Thank you for your understanding as we work towards providing a safe environment for our students, families, staff and volunteers.

Volunteers

1. Volunteers will be trained in proper face mask use, hand washing techniques and signs/symptoms of COVID 19. Training will be documented.
2. A temperature check and health screening will be done upon entry to property. Documentation will be made in volunteer files.
3. On arrival, volunteers will be required to wash their hands at the *volunteer/staff only* wash station.
4. Volunteers will wear face masks the entire time they are on property.
5. Volunteers will be encouraged to bring their own masks however a small supply will be available on site.
6. Each Volunteer will be assigned a specific work area and tasks based on their skills. For example: volunteers who know how to tack will be assigned to the barn.
7. There will be a 6 foot distancing area in the barn for tacking and grooming.

Staff

1. Staff will be trained in proper face mask use, hand washing techniques and signs/symptoms of COVID 19. Training will be documented.
2. A temperature check and health screening will be done upon entry to property. Documentation will be made in staff files.
3. On arrival staff will be required to wash their hands at the *volunteer/staff only* wash station.
4. Each instructor have an infection control apron. The apron will contain supplies to mitigate contamination by bodily fluids including properly folded masks, sanitizer, tissues and Ziploc bags (for soiled tissues).
Aprons to be machine washed daily.
5. Instructors will wear their masks during mounting and whenever within proximity of others, but will remove and store mask according to CDC infection control guidelines when further away for clear communication.
6. There will be a 6 foot distancing area in the barn for tacking and grooming.

Horses

Horses that are used in class will be bathed after each rider; if they are to be used back to back, they will be sponge off along their withers, neck and head.

Facility

1. Will disinfect bathroom frequently.
2. There will be signs indicating handwashing stations, procedures, etc.
3. Disinfectants will follow the CDC recommendations.
4. Used linens will be placed in washer in outhouse for cleaning.
